Brief description:	<p>Five parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a basic introduction to economics as a subject; • economic policy in general (micro and macro); • the policy mix in the euro-area (fiscal and monetary); • the financial sector with particular reference to the recent financial crisis; • the external dimension (trade and balance of payments). <p>The tutor refers to economic theories and current affairs in discussing these areas, and provides topical articles and EU DG ECFIN documents as background material and offer ideas for further reading.</p>
